What indicator plant is in bloom in Dupage County? Norway Maple (*Acer platanoides*) is in early flower (fig. 1) Accumulated Growing Degree Days (Base 50): 44.5 (as of <u>April 23</u>) Accumulated Growing Degree Days (Base 30): 804.5 (as of <u>April 23</u>)
